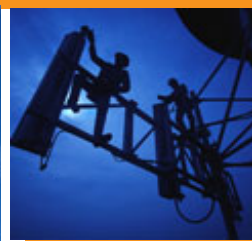

Technical staff who use rigging on telecommunications radio structures apply the skills and knowledge in this unit. They may make use of rigging plant and equipment, fall arrest, fall guarding and fall constraint and work in teams.

- ▶ Fall dynamics
- ▶ Inspection requirements for working at heights
- ▶ Prepare to use safe rigging practices
- ▶ Prepare climbing equipment
- ▶ Assess the status and condition of vertical / telecommunications network structures and identify climbing route
- ▶ Climb vertical and telecommunications network structures
- ▶ Use climbing and working fall arrest systems
- ▶ Controlling risks associated with rope rescue
- ▶ Inspection and maintenance of rope rescue equipment
- ▶ Perform rescues
- ▶ EMR awareness
- ▶ Tying of knots
